WATERBORNE PATINA

Patina for aged, decapé, decorative effects

DESCRIPTION:

WATERBORNE PATINA is a professional product, mainly used to give an aged/decapé or decorative effect. Thanks to its special formulation the product can be easily applied on PU, acrylic, UV and lacquered basecoats. It's suitable for any wooden surface. Easy removal after drying.

PHYSICAL-CHEMICAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Form:	Thick liquid
Colour:	See label
Drying time (20°C):	15-20'
Dilution:	Water

HOW TO USE:

Mix well before use to grant the homogeneity of the material, that could sometimes stratify. Prepare WATERBORNE PATINA for use: dilute 10-30% with water, depending on your needs. On a pre-treated surface (one or more coats of basecoat, possibly protected with a transparent coat to get a more defined effect) apply the patina with a consumption of 30-50 g/sqm, single coat. After 20' the patina is dried. Clean the surface with some steel wool or an abrasive pad to remove patina where needed and get an aged or decapé effect. Apply a transparent finish to protect the patina.

STORAGE:

The shelf life of the product is 12 months long from the date of manufacture, in its original packaging, tightly closed.

PACKAGE:

The product comes in 250 ml, 1L, 5L, 20L sized cans.
