They are small and portable and have IPX4 water resistance. Additionally, you can use these sweat- and water-resistant in-ear headphones for up to 7 hours on a single charge; the pocket-sized wireless charging case will give you three more charges.

How to pair earbuds?

1. The earbuds should be in pairing mode. Consult the instructions that came with the earphones if you're unsure how to do it.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your iOS or Android smartphone.
3. Select Pair after locating your earbuds in the list of compatible devices.

How to wear earbuds?

Put the earbud tips in your ear canal and twist the headphones into position to wear them. To do this, gently pull up on the top of your ears. Making ensuring the headphones are positioned correctly and firmly in the ear canal is made simple by doing this.

How do I charge the case for my earbuds?

Connect the charging case to an approved wall charger or USB power source. The charging case and earbuds take around two hours to fully charge. Note: Charge times may be greater with uncertified chargers.

How will I know when my earbuds are fully charged?

When the case is fully charged, a light will appear to let you know that it is time to put your earbuds in the case so they can begin charging. You may charge earbuds using a USB connection; simply connect to charge.

Can earphones be worn while charging?

Yes. While using the USB charging wire to charge your headset, you can still use it. If a cable—such as an audio or charging cable—is attached to the headset's USB port, you might notice a modest increase in warmth there.

How can I activate my earbuds?

Toggle the listed headphones. Pull down the phone's top shade on an Android device, then long-press the Bluetooth icon. It will immediately take you to the Bluetooth menu, where you may enable it and then start looking for devices. To link a pair of headphones, tap their name.

Do Bluetooth earbuds shut off on their own?

Bluetooth headphones are inefficient energy users. So as to help with energy conservation, they will switch themselves off when not in use. The device might also shut off on its own when the battery runs out. When not in use, the Bluetooth headphones are set to shut off.

How can you tell whether your Lenovo are fully charged?

To start charging the Lenovo TWS headset, just open the charging box cover and place the device inside. When charging starts, the headset's LED indicator flashes red; when charging is complete, it turns off.
